### LEBANON TRIP

#### OVERVIEW

**WHEN:** September 20–28, 2024

**WHERE:** Beirut, Lebanon

**WHO:** Anyone 18 or older can attend. Eligibility will be based on application, space and membership.

**COST:** \$2,700 – Trip price covers all costs associated with food, tours, training, lodging and travel. The only amount not covered will be any food or snacks personally purchased on the journey to and from Lebanon or any souvenirs you purchase.

#### DETAILS:

**TEAM LEADER:** Clay Baker

**LODGING:** You will stay at the ABTS facility. This is a seminary campus, so expect dormitory lodging.

**APPLICATION DEADLINE:** May 19, 2024

Arab Baptist Theological Seminary, ABTS for short, is one of Harmony's Global Partners. This means that we regularly partner with the staff and students as they take the gospel to the nations. Lebanon is a very special place, because it is a county in the Middle East where Christianity is a legal religion. ABTS can exist, train and mobilize believers from all of the Middle East without fear or threat of persecution.

While life in Lebanon is hard both politically and economically, you will learn on this trip that God is working and moving in the lives of many people in the Middle East. Your time at ABTS will include visits to various locations around the country. You will hear from the faculty and students at ABTS, meet with refugees, and learn more about Muslim culture as you interact with people from all over the Middle East.
